Art. 1: EVENT PROGRAM

The 2022 Annecy Lake Marathon and Duo Marathon edition is organized by Annecy Haute Savoie Athletics (AHSA) and will take place on April 17th, 2022

The 2022 Annecy Lake Half Marathon is organized by Annecy Haute Savoie Athletics (AHSA) and will take place on April 17th, 2022

The 2022 Annecy Lake 10KM edition is organized by Annecy Haute Savoie Athletics (AHSA) and will take place on April 17th, 2022

The 2022 Annecy Lake Nordic Walk edition is organized by Annecy Haute Savoie Athletics (AHSA) and will take place on April 17th, 2022

The 2022 Youth race edition is organized by Annecy Haute Savoie Athlétisme (AHSA) and will take place on April 16th, 2022

Art. 2: LOCATION

ATTENTION: Courses are being validated and will be disclosed shortly. As usual, courses will take place beside the lake. For 2022, contrary to 2021, courses will be FFA certified.

Art. 3: PARTICIPANTS

The races are open to runners:

- Born before 2006 December 31, for the 10km
- Born before 2004 December 31, for the half marathon
- Born before 2002 December 31, for the marathon

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AND LICENSE

Any participation in a competition is subject to the mandatory presentation, by the participants to the organizer:

- An Athlé Compétition, Athlé Entreprise, Athlé Running license issued by the FFA, or a "Pass'
 J'aime Courir" issued by the FFA and completed by the doctor, valid on the date of the event.
 (Attention: other licenses issued by the FFA (Health, Management and Discovery) are not accepted);
- Or a sports license, valid on the date of the event, on which must appear, by any means, the noncontraindication to the practice of sport in competition, athletics in competition or running in competition and issued by one of the following federations:
 - Fédération des clubs de la défense (FCD),
 - Fédération française du sport adapté (FFSA),
 - Fédération française handisport (FFH),
 - o Fédération sportive de la police nationale (FSPN),
 - Fédération sportive des ASPTT,
 - o Fédération sportive et culturelle de France (FSCF),
 - o Fédération sportive et gymnique du travail (FSGT),
 - Union française des œuvres laïgues d'éducation physique (UFOLEP);



- Or a medical certificate of absence of contraindication to the practice of sport in competition or athletics in competition or running in competition, dating less than three years at the date of the competition, or its copy. No other document can be accepted as proof of possession of the medical certificate.
 - It is imperative to attach it to the supporting documents when you register. No medical certificate in paper will be accepted.
- The attestation document for minors
- A valid health pass
 (Measure that will follow the progress in the weeks and months to come)

Participants with foreign licenses will still have to provide a medical certificate, in English, mentioning the non-contraindication to the practice of running. This certificate may have been issued in their country of origin.



Art. 4: REGISTRATIONS

Registration for the race opens on November 03, 2021 and will close on April 10 at midnight. Marathon:

Half-Marathon:

- From January 01 to February 28, 2022 : 43€
- From March 01 to April 10, 2022 : 45€

10KM:

- From November 03 to December 31, 2021 : 25€
- From January 01 to February 28, 2022 : 27€
- From March 01 to April 10, 2022 : 30€

Youth race:

Free of charge

Art. 5: TIME BARRIERS

The time barrier is the cut-off time set by the organization to start from a point. It is a security element for:

- Taking runners out of the race
- Secure eliminated runners and organize their repatriation to the finish area

These barriers will be placed on the 10km route.

Art. 6: BONUSES AND REWARDS

Only competitors present at the awards ceremony will be eligible for rewards and bonuses. Any scratch rider (male or female) who does not show up for these protocols would be considered to give up any reward.

Art. 7: ENVIRONNEMENT RESPECT

In order to respect the environment and the natural spaces crossed, it is strictly forbidden to leave waste (paper, plastic packaging, etc.) on the route.

Garbage cans will be available at each fuelling station and COLLECTION AREAS will be installed and marked at different points along the route. They must be used by the participants in the events. They will have to store the waste and packaging while waiting for the places indicated by the organization to get rid of it.

Art. 8: DRONES

Participants are informed that on the day of the event, remotely piloted aircraft (drones) may be used for filming purposes.

The participants will be able to stand, during all or part of their participation in the event, at less than 30 meters from the aircrafts.

In the event of a major flight incident, an audible signal will alert nearby participants who will then have to move away from the aircraft.

Art. 9: RESTRICTION

The introduction on the site of the event of all objects likely to be dangerous or illegal, in particular drugs, firearms, blunt objects and explosive materials is strictly prohibited.

To access the site and to participate in the event, the participant expressly acknowledges and accepts that the organizer then calls upon security personnel who will be empowered to control both the persons and their personal effects. Any person wishing to access the site agrees to submit to this control. In case of refusal the person will not be allowed to access the site.



Art. 10: INSURANCE

As part of the organization of the race, AHSA has taken out, in accordance with the legislation in force, an insurance covering the financial consequences of its civil liability, that of its employees and of all participants in the youth race. Regarding the liability of the participants, the intervention of this insurance for the latter is limited to the accidents that they could cause during the sporting event.

At the same time, participants are offered to take out insurance guaranteeing the payment of a capital in case of personal injury (death or permanent disability) due to an accident occurring on the race route. Compensation, depending on the damage and the limits of the guarantees chosen, occurs when the insured is the victim of an accident during his participation in the sports event. This insurance is optional but highly recommended. It may be taken out in addition to or in the absence of insurance of the same type held through a sports licence. The information notice and the registration form are available on the event website (Registration -> Supplementary insurance).

Finally, the organizer declines all responsibility in case of damage (theft, breakage, loss, etc.) suffered by the personal property of the participants. Participants will therefore not be able to turn against the organizer for any damage to their equipment.

Art. 11: PRE-RACE

The bibs awarding and participant packs will take place in the week before the race until the race day. An email will be sent to all participants to let them know where and when to withdraw.

The presentation of the following documents will be required:

- ID
- Charged with registration.
- Health pass (depending on legislation at race time).

No bibs can be removed at any other time.

Art. 12: RACE PROGRESS

The marathon start will take place at 8:30 am on Sunday April 17th. The 10km start will take place at 9:30 am on Sunday April 17th. The Half-marathon start will take place at 2:00 pm on Sunday April 17th. The Nordic walk start will take place at 9:00am on Sunday April 17th. The youth race start will take place on Saturday 16th. The races will take place on pedestrian and bicycle routes. Refueling is planned at 5kmfor the 10km. All start times will be confirmed by email or SMS minimum 2 weeks before the official start. The waste must be placed in the bins available on the route. It is forbidden to throw waste on the course under penalty of disqualification.

The route is marked and a mileage mark will be visible every kilometer The use of headphones and telephone is not recommended. Their use is your responsibility. The participants undertake not to use any assistance on the course (cycling, rollerblades, etc.) The bib must remain visible throughout the course and until the crossing of the finish line. The loss of the bib on the course is eliminatory. Any antisports behaviour found or detected will result in disqualification.

A snack will be given on arrival



Art. 13: SECURITY

The event security will be ensured throughout the event.

Security on the route will be provided jointly by volunteer signallers and members of the municipal police as well as security officers on the Pâquier Village.

The finish is strictly reserved for runners registered in the race. NO accompanying person or child will be accepted to pass the finish.

A principal medical point is planned at the finish of the race with Doctors and Rescuers. Different medical points will be also planned on the course on strategic points.

Art. 14: RESULTS

Results will be fully communicated upon arrival of the race **if COVID measures allow**. They will also be available on the event website and on social networks. They will also be communicated to you personally after the race.

Art. 15: TIMING AND TIME LIST

The timing of the race will be displayed at the finish and mid-course.

Art. 16: RANKING

Several categories will ba ranked on those races:

- Men Scratch Homme
- Women Scratch Femme
- Age categories (Men / Women)

Art. 17: IMAGE RIGHTS

By participating in Annecy Lake 2022 Races, each participant expressly authorises the organizer, its rights holders or assigns to fix and reproduce, on any medium and by any means, and consequently to reproduce and represent, without remuneration of any kind, its name, voice, image, and more generally its sporting performance in the context of the Trial, in any form, on any existing or future support, in any format, for any communication to the public throughout the world, for any use, including for advertising and/or commercial purposes, and for the duration of the current copyright protection provided by law or regulation, judicial and/or arbitral decisions of any country and current or future international conventions, including any extensions that may be made to this term. Each participant expressly and irrevocably authorises the organizer, its assigns, in order to meet the requirements of advertising, promotional and/or commercial campaigns to 1) make any modification, addition, deletion, that it will deem useful for the exploitation of its image under the conditions defined above; 2) to associate and/or combine with its image, all signatures, hooks, slogans, legends, marks, distinctive signs, legal, visual and, generally any element of any kind chosen by the organiser, in particular to illustrate the communication media in which they are integrated. The participant guarantees not to be bound by any exclusive contract relating to the use of his image and/or his name and/or his voice. The organizer, his rights holders, his rights holders expressly forbid himself to use the name, voice or image of the participants in a medium of pornographic, racist, xenophobic, and more generally, prevent any exploitation that is detrimental to the dignity of the participants.



Art. 18: COMMUNICATION

By registering for the 2022 Annecy Lake Races, you agree to be contacted by AHSA in the framework of upcoming events to be organized.

Art. 19: MODIFICATION - POSTPONEMENT - CANCELLATION

If circumstances require, the Organizer reserves the right to change at any time the route, the position of the refueling and chronometric points, to postpone the date and/or times of the Event, to stop the current Event, cancel it or set up a fallback route. Should the Event be cancelled for any reason beyond the control of the Organizer presenting the characteristics of force majeure as defined by Article 1218 of the Civil Code and by French jurisprudence, the latter may propose, depending on the circumstances, compensation such as the substitution of another Event organised by the Organiser, the postponement of the Event or the reimbursement of the race-bib price minus, where applicable, the application fee, excluding any other sum.

Art. 20: GDPR

In accordance with the French Data Protection Act of 6 January 1978, competitors have a right of access and restrictions to their personal data. Through the organiser, competitors may receive proposals from other companies or associations

Art. 21: COVID-19

Each participant agrees to follow to the letter the recommendations of the Ministry of Sports as well as those of the Prefect of Haute-Savoie in order to participate in the race.

The measures will be available on the government website https://www.gouvernement.fr/info-coronavirus. Failure to comply with these measures will result in disqualification.

As the measures change regularly, our team is in constant contact with the town hall and the health authorities and will be entitled to make changes in the regulations in order to corroborate with the prefectural directives.

Art. 22: RULES ACCEPTANCE

By registering for the Annecy Lake races 2022, you acknowledge that you have taken note of these rules and agree to comply with them.
